

1 SECURITY POLICY

1.1 Purpose

To ensure that OWL is ensured of a certain level of security in conformance with ISPS regulations.

1.2 Scope

This document applies to all employees of OWL. In addition, it applies to personnel contracted by OWL to complete work on their behalf.

1.3 Policy

It is the policy of the OWL to continuously promote a secure working environment both within our own office and working environment and on board vessels involved in OWL operations.

OWL is therefore committed to: -

- The security of our own office and all of our equipment
- Assess and monitor the security aspects of all vessels involved in OWL operations.
- Avoid the possibility of security incidents that could cause human injury, loss of life or damage to ships and property.
- Ensure fast and efficient exchange of security related information.
- Establish safeguards against identified risks.
- Comply with statutory and legislative as applicable.

In order to effectively implement the Security Policy OWL:

- Makes a sensible and informed effort to ensure the security of its offices and equipment
- Takes into account all related guidelines, standards, codes and publications as applicable
- Cooperates with port authorities and shore based facilities to enhance security level during OWL operation.
- Implements procedures to prepare and respond to security related emergency situations.
- Gathers information with respect to security threats and promotes the information exchange regarding security incidents.
- All Company employees and contracted staff are responsible for implementing the company's Security Policy.
